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Rachel's work focuses on the interlinkages between economics, finance, and security issues, as well as coercive economic policies such as sanctions, economic resilience and the role of state-owned investors including sovereign wealth funds. She has a particular interest in the macroeconomic and foreign policy of China and oil-exporting nations, including sovereign wealth management and energy-sector supply risks and resilience. She does extensive work on global macroeconomic issues, including foreign-exchange reserve accumulation, economic imbalances and trade and investment policy.
